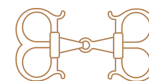

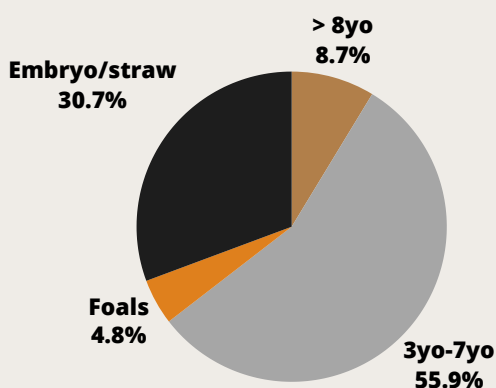
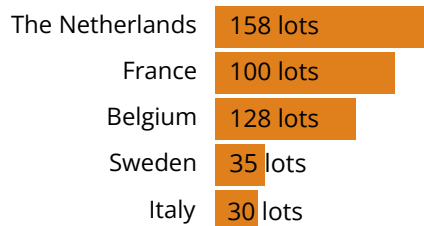

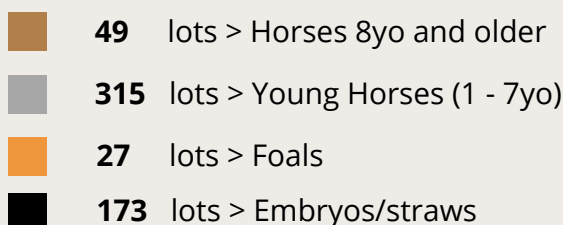

Top five auction countries

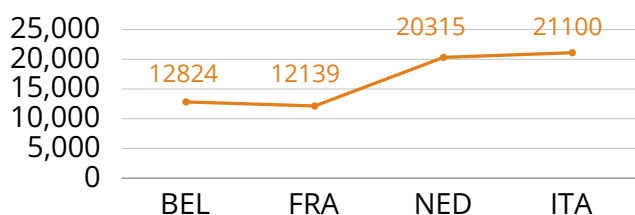


Breakdown sold lots in total

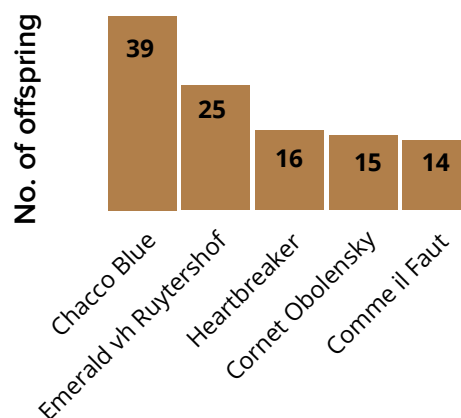


Average embryo prices per country

Highest selling auction & individual lots

The busiest auction months are over and we are seeing a shift in the type of lots being sold. Whereas foals top the ranks in the summer and fall, in the month of November there are more young horses and embryos sold. The total number of lots auctioned is 565 in total with the **Capital Stud Auction** in South Africa being the auction with the highest average and top individual lot price. Capital Saffier, a 5yo Harley VDL x Contender was sold for the highest price of **64.595,00** euro. The full collection totalled a number of 642.960,00 euro with an average selling price per lot of **29.225,00** euro.
