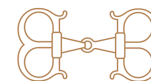
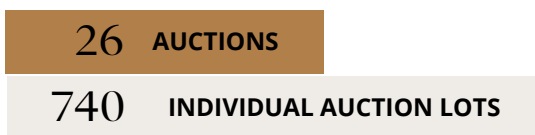


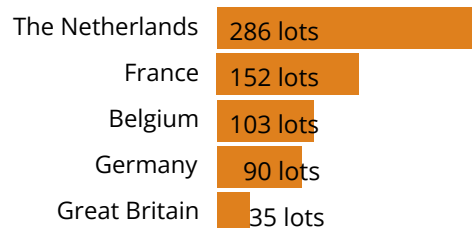

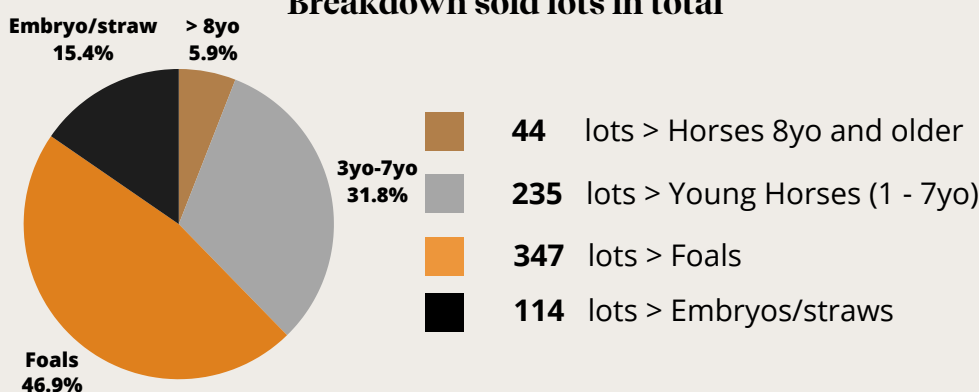

Top five auction countries

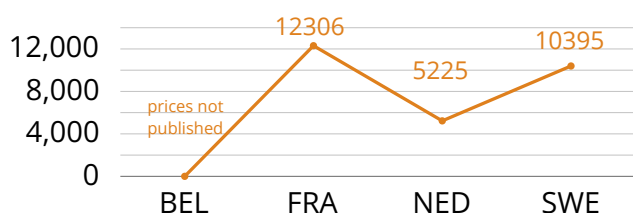


Breakdown sold lots in total

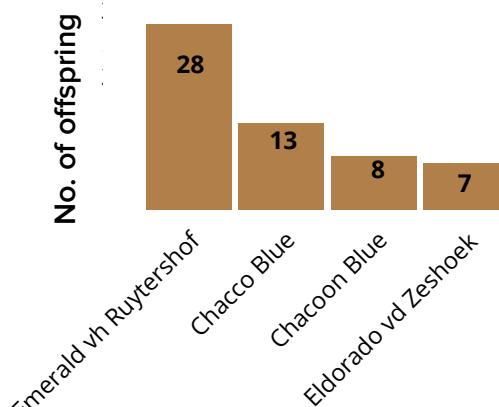


Average foal prices per country

Highest selling auction & individual lots

October shows more than a 50% decline in lots sold at auction in comparison with September. Also the selling prices are less but still impressive. Five-year-old mare Billy Off-Pist (Billy du Montois x Winningmood) which sold in **The Billy Stud Auction (GBR)** claimed **the highest selling price of 110.200 euro**, just topping the sales price of **110.000 euro** paid for **Extra WS**, a 3yo mare by Emerald van 't Ruytershof x For Pleasure sold in **The Youngsters Auction (NED)**.

The highest average selling price at a foal auction plus the highest selling price for a foal where both at the **Ekestrian Showjumping Elite Auction** The most expensive foal was a Chacco Blue x Chin Chin filly sold for 31.200 euro the average selling price was 18.813 euro.
